- 2. Parents and guardians are responsible for the safety of their child when they paint. Please use good judgment.
- 3. Painter is responsible for all materials used.
- 4. Only the child (children), family, group, or adult who is (are) registered to paint may paint. This is an Art Contest and prizes are given out based on age and category.
- 5. No profanity or political statements, and art must be appropriate for all ages.
- 6. Make sure your work space is clean when you leave. Clean up all materials and spills. This paint will stain trim paint, brick, stone and mortar if left to dry!
- 7. Please be courteous of all pedestrians and business customers/patrons while you paint.
- 8. If you paint early in the week and are concerned about what the weather might do to your masterpiece prior to judging, please take a photo of your completed window and email it to production@lakewoodobserver.com before Wednesday, October 28.
