Due to the current public health emergency situation, for the safety of the police and others involved, and for the protection of the community, effective March 13, 2020, for all arrest warrants previously issued by the Lakewood Municipal Court except pending felony charges or:

- 1) domestic violence,
- 2) violation of protection order,
- 3) aggravated menacing,
- 4) menacing by stalking,
- 5) aggravated trespass, or
- 6) bonds in excess of \$3,000 cash or 10%,

The defendant, in the discretion of the police, may be released without arrest or bond unless a police officer determines that arrest is necessary due to risk of non-appearance in court by the defendant or risk of harm to the defendant, victim, or the community.

If the defendant is released without arrest, the defendant shall be given the next Tuesday date at 9:00 a.m. to appear in the Lakewood Municipal Court. If the defendant is released without arrest, the Lakewood Police shall either execute the warrant on the defendant or return the unexecuted warrant to the Lakewood Court with written notice that the defendant was released without arrest and given the Tuesday court date for appearance.

Nothing in this order shall prohibit the Lakewood Police or Law Department from contacting the undersigned judge directly to modify the bond for any of the exceptions listed in this order to permit the release of the defendant without bond.
